- 4. Corona safety behaviours to be made strict in hospitals/ clinics

- 6. To focus on mental wellness of doctors especially those who are burnout because of endless COVID duty.
- 7. To discuss with state IMA leaders and convey to government authority on strategy to focus more on mass vaccination rather than mass testing.
- 8 Vaccination for bed ridden patients under pain and palliative care will be supervised and undertaken by IMA.
- 9. To pass a resolution and send to state IMA to restrict mass gatherings after election results.
